College Board is launching in 2019-2020 a new AP Classroom online with:

- Access to AP Question bank for AP Audit approved teachers
- Unit resources
- Performance tracking
- Data disaggregated automatically by teacher AND by class section
- Students indicate on the College Board site their Exam participation decision
- Personalized AP Exam labels for students (No more Pre-Admin!)
- **AND: NEW DEADLINES (October 4: Priority Ordering and November 15: Regular Ordering)**

What does this mean for me as an AP Coordinator?

- More detailed Fall set up in the College Board system; more time
- No more pre-admin! But more cross referencing of payments and student enrollments
- Cross referencing student exam decision indicators and payments
- Communication with Admin and Teachers to ensure preparedness for the timeline shift
- Make sure you have support! What kind? Like having APTS in your corner ;)

How can AP Test Service support me as a coordinator?

- Variety of payment timelines and setups to support best practices in the new model
- Invoicing of students who indicated YES to taking the exam (delivered to their inbox!)
- Cross-referencing: Get a quick report of who has NOT paid exam fees yet!
